Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of Bal-Vatika shall be restricted to 3 (one section each in Bal Vatika I, II & III respectively) and the total number of sections of the school from class I to X shall be restricted to 10. The optimum number of students in each section shall be restricted to 30 as per the specification/area of the available classrooms. Further, increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sq ft dimension.

2	As undertaken by the school, all classrooms in the newly constructed building will be 8m x 6m (48 sqm) or bigger. School shall shift the classes in the classrooms of 500 Sqft or rooms with bigger dimensions in the new building and submit the compliance within 03 months.
3	Special Educator and Counsellor and Wellness Teacher not appointed school shall appoint qualified Special Educator and Counsellor and Wellness Teacher within 03 months and submit the compliance.
4	Library undersized and understocked. Separate area for reading of staff is not developed. School shall shift it to some bigger room and to upgrade the library as per SOP given in the circular 11/2022 within 03 months and submit the compliance.
5	Composite Science Lab divided in two rooms 1 room with Physics section and 1 room is developed as Chemistry & Biology Lab. Labs does not have the safe storage, exhaust fan. The lab does not have the workstation with the fixture as running water with sink, gas, electric supply. School is directed to set-up the Lab in the bigger room of adequate dimension and install the required equipment at workstation with water, electric supply ad safety measures as per SOP given in the circular 11/2022 within 03 months and submit the compliance.
6	Mathematics Lab is undersized and few aids are placed on the tables as makeshift arrangement. There is no space on table to conduct the activity. School shall setup the Lab in a bigger room and as per SOP given in the circular 11/2022 within 03 months and submit the compliance.
7	Computer Lab is undersized and only 20 computers are installed whereas minimum 40 computer nods are required as per SOP issued by the Board. School shall procure and install minimum 40 computers in the Lab and shift the lab in a bigger room within 03 months and submit the compliance.
8	Ramp and CwSN toilets for Girls and Boys are not available on each floor as per guidelines of the Board and RPWD Act. As undertaken by the school 8. Thus, School shall construct the ramp with proper incline or install the lift along with the CwSN toilets separately for boys and girls on each floor with sufficient space for easy movement of the wheelchair as well as handrail on both side of toilet seat (fixed and movable) and proper permanent signage (on the cubicle indicating the floor number) as per guidelines of the Board and norms of RPwD Act within 03 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.

4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/ LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
